ROD'S RECIPE

From Executive Chef Rodney Cole

"Budweiser" Citrus Chicken Wings

2 ounces	butter	
1 tablespoon	garlic crushed	
1/2 cup	sliced scallions	
1 can	Budweiser	
1 cup	brown sugar	
1	orange- juiced	
1	lemon-zested and juiced	
1	lime –zested and juiced	
1/4 cup	light teriyaki sauce	
1 tbsp each	Cilantro and parsley-chopped	
1 tbsp	fresh ginger root	
1/2 teaspoon each	salt and black pepper	
	Couple shakes hot sauce	
1-2 pounds	raw chicken wings	

How to do it:

1. Cook garlic and scallions in the butter until soft and tender.
2. Next add the remaining ingredients except the wings, and bring to a boil for 2-3 minutes then take off heat. Add the herbs then allow to cool.
3. Take 1-2 pounds of large raw chicken wings and marinate in the refrigerator for about 60-90 minutes. Remove wings from marinade.
4. Pre-heat BBQ and spray with a little non stick cooking spray and cook wings on a medium/high heat, turning often until crispy and thoroughly cooked.
5. For a dip, mix together 3 parts Ranch dressing and 2 parts Budweiser BBQ sauce.
